

On the Road to Your Dreams


May you meet every challenge you are faced with, recognize every precious opportunity, and be blessed with the knowledge that you have the ability to make every day special.



The teachers on Special Duty were also honoured with badges as they took the oath to empower the young Karenites of the newly formed Student Council.






Let's Celebrate today in Unity!






Special Assemblies






EduTribes






BAGLESS



Everyone was happy and enjoyed it very much and also encouraged the children with applause.




In our school the students from Kindergarten to Std. 4 showed their interest in the competition by exploring with colours according to the group wise topics.





BLUE DAY




RED DAY




GRANDPARENT'S DAY






Teacher's DAY







5 Body Safety Rules







Animals Day







Sing a song of flowers
