We wish all our readers a very happy reading!

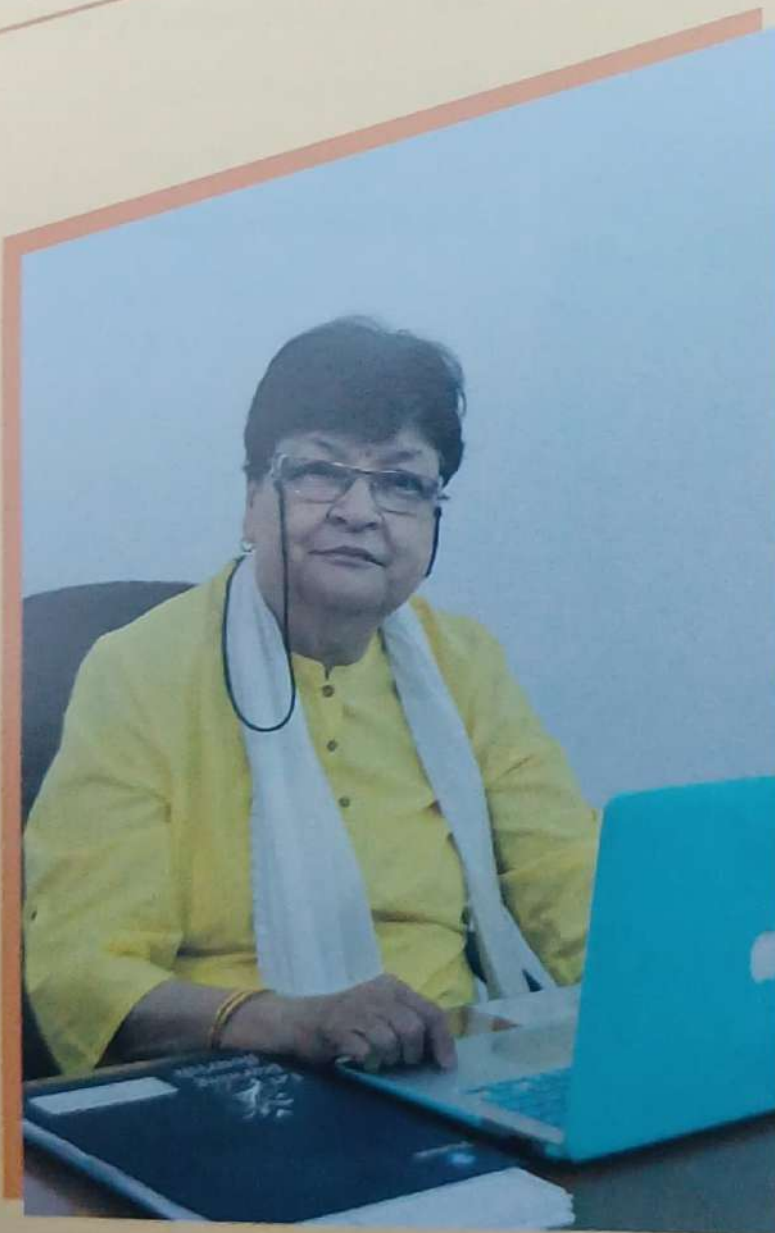


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Message from the Headmistress

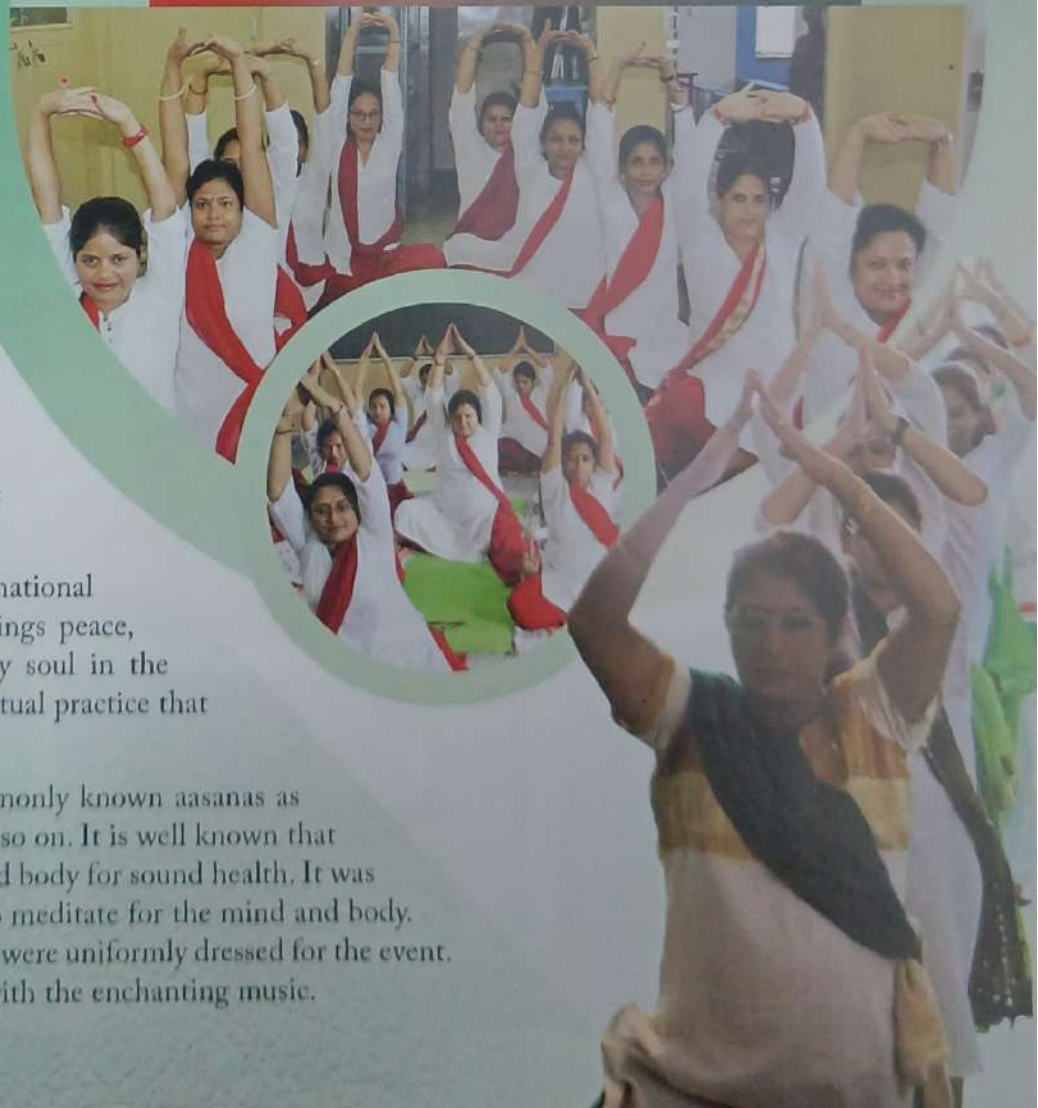


Yoga Day

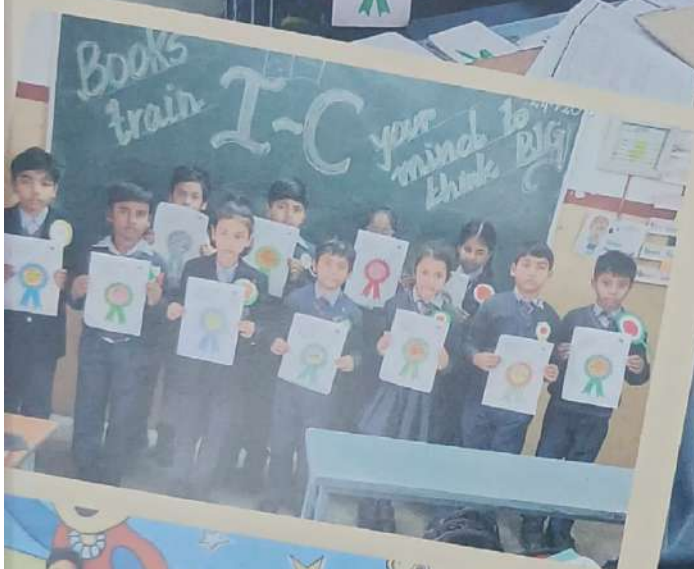
मेरा अनुभव

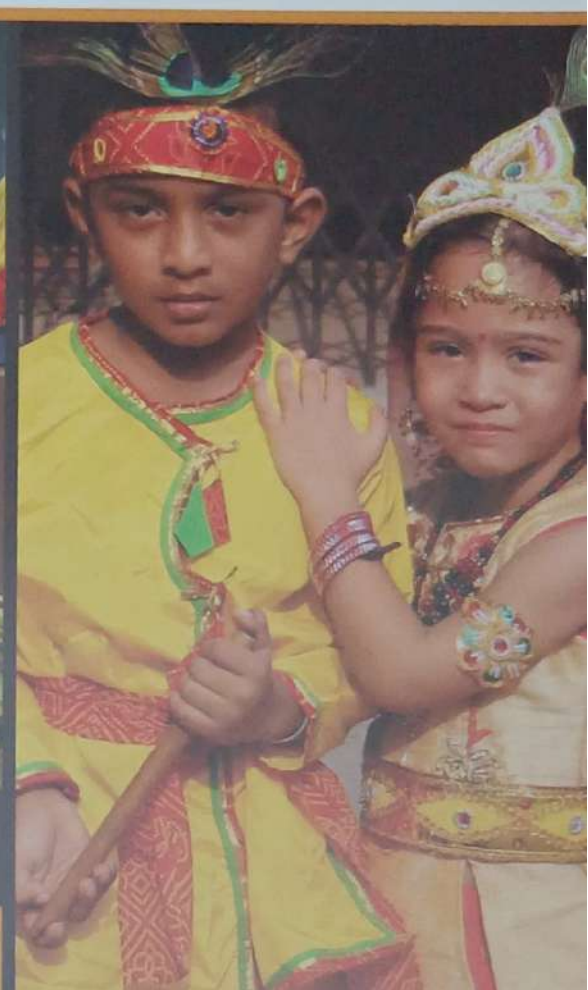

The celebration of 'Festival of Lights' leads us from darkness to brightness.

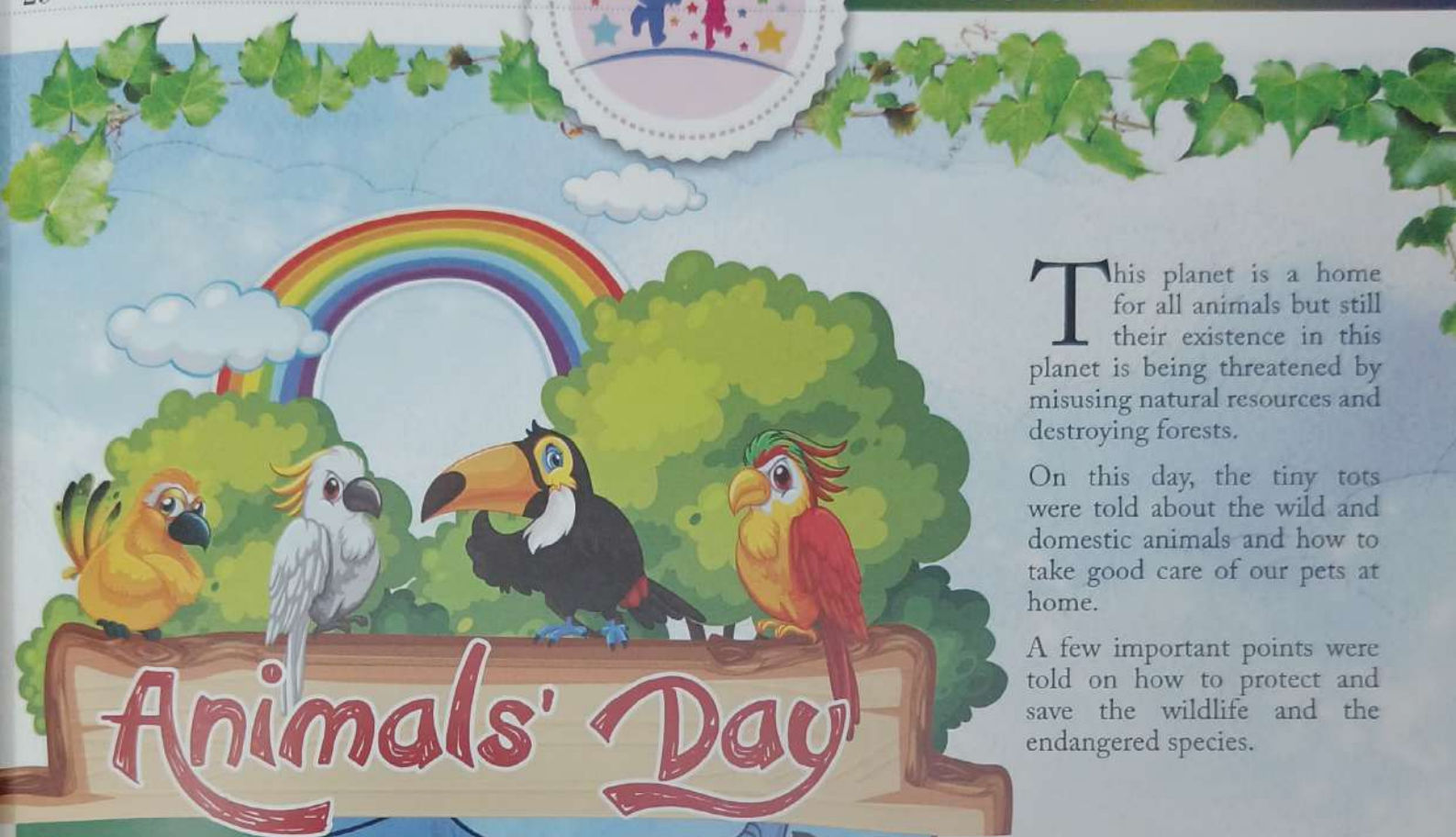
